CALIFORNIA'S 27TH ASSEMBLY DISTRICT DEBATE

Merced, CA - On Monday, October 17, 2022 from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m., The Maddy Institute will be hosting a debate, moderated by Executive Director Mark Keppler, between the candidates for California's 27th Assembly District, Republican Mark Pazin and Democrat Esmeralda Soria.
