

SUMMER 2025 AG SCHOLAR INTERN PROGRAM APPLICATION

The Agricultural Policy Internship Program will offer an opportunity for Valley students to gain hands-on experience working full-time during the summer in Sacramento with a State agency that regulates various aspects of California agriculture government. Interns will have the opportunity to:

- Gain a deeper understanding of how state regulations are promulgated and enforced.
- Have direct insight into how a state regulatory agency operates on a daily basis.
- Gain insight in how state regulators interact with California's key agricultural stakeholders and policymakers.
- Develop public leadership skills to help pursue a career in agricultural policy and advocacy.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must have a 3.0 overall GPA or higher
- Must be at least a Junior in standing (60 units) OR enrolled in a Graduate program during the Summer
- Must be able to work full-time during the Summer

<u>APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS</u>

- Completed Application: All sections must be completed and signed.
- Current Resume
- Personal Statement: No longer than ONE page with your name on the document. Write a short biographical sketch. Explain how an office would benefit from having you as an intern. What interest, experience, or background do you have in agriculture, public policy or government affairs (school, work, volunteerism, etc.)? When and how have you exhibited leadership? What is your long-term commitment to making the Valley a better place?
- **College Transcripts:** Copies of unofficial transcripts are acceptable. <u>Please submit as a PDF.</u> Your name and total GPA <u>must</u> appear on the document.
